MRCI WorkSource Continues Partnership with Rasmussen College

MANKATO - MRCI WorkSource, a leader in adult rehabilitation services and programs, has announced the continuation of a partnership with Rasmussen College that provides 22 nursing students with internships at our Mankato facilities.

The partnership, which began three years ago, places Rasmussen nursing students under continuous supervision in MRCI's Day Training & Habilitation Program. The program serves individuals with a wide range of developmental & physical disabilities. Linda Leiding, Senior Vice President of Programs at MRCI, said the internship program with Rasmussen gives the students exposure to individuals with developmental disabilities and an understanding of some of the unique challenges individuals face.

"Having students here from Rasmussen College has been beneficial to both organizations," said Leiding. "It gives the students some experience in working with and caring for the individuals we serve, but it also provides the DT&H program with an individual who can spend some time with a variety of people."

In addition to interacting with consumers at MRCI, the non-profit organization also helps Rasmussen students by providing them access to MRCI's onsite nurse, direct-support professionals, and training.
